AND GOD SAYS . . .

Jesus answered, "I am the way and THE TRUTH and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6 NIV, Capitalization mine)

They perish because they refused to love THE TRUTH and so be saved. For this reason God sends them a powerful delusion so that they will believe THE LIE (2 Thess 2:10-11 NIV, Capitalization mine)

I place these two scriptures in juxtaposition to each other to emphasize the criticalness of understanding and believing in the truth. It is necessary for life, for success, and for direction. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved" (Romans 10:9-11 NIV) This is the most important application.

If you don't choose to do this, no matter how good you are, your life will ultimately fail and end in eternal torment (Luke 16:19-28). That is because all of us, by default, are sinners. We are born sinners and under the bondage of sin. Furthermore if we do not choose to truly believe Jesus, we remain under Satan's control. Jesus called him the "father of lies" and named him as the one who is over us (John 8:44).

So you are not your own (1 Corinthians 6:19-20) , you are either under the authority of Jesus, or deceived by the lie and under the authority of sin and Satan. To serve Jesus leads to life and godliness, to serve Satan leads to sin and death (Romans 8:6-8). That's the choice you have to make.

HITTING AGRICULTURE

Rural America was a solid base of support for Donald Trump and the Republican Party. We believed we were respected and guaranteed protection from economic uncertainty and dangerous influences.

But now, Agriculture, too, has come under attack. Farm families, and the communities who support them, will see hardship ahead.

Tariffs have become a weapon in trade wars started by the government against, well, just about everyone. Tariff rates have ranged from 10% to 145%.

TARIFFS AFFECT THE CONSUMER TWICE

1. Tariffs are really a TAX on us. Tariffs are not collected against another country. They are collected at the border from those who want to import goods and parts. Then the extra cost is passed on to us. Walmart just announced price increases for all their goods from China. Our government told them to eat the costs themselves, not to pass on the cost. (Our government has admitted that we pay for the tariffs.) Tariffs may slow production in other countries but the fines are paid by us.

2. Other nations respond with tariffs against our goods, making it harder for us to export what we make – including agricultural products.

The soybeans, pork and chicken that we were exporting to China will no longer go there. They will need to find a new home in the world market or be eaten at home. We could see a contraction in the pork and poultry industries because of lack of demand. Pork and poultry already have extremely tight margins and any restrictions placed on foreign markets will put more pressure on our farmers and packers.

The pressure our government hopes to place on other countries will backfire. Since 2018 China has diversified their soybean market to include Brazil and Argentina. We were already shipping less and less soybeans to them but soon won't ship any due to the tariffs.

Under the president's economy, farm costs will rise. Farm incomes will drop. Farmers will pay more for fertilizer. They will pay more for farm equipment. They will pay more for the fuel to ship their products to market. The communities and businesses that support local farming will see their incomes drop. When foreign countries retaliate, American farmers will lose export markets.

Support from rural America will be paid back in hardship.

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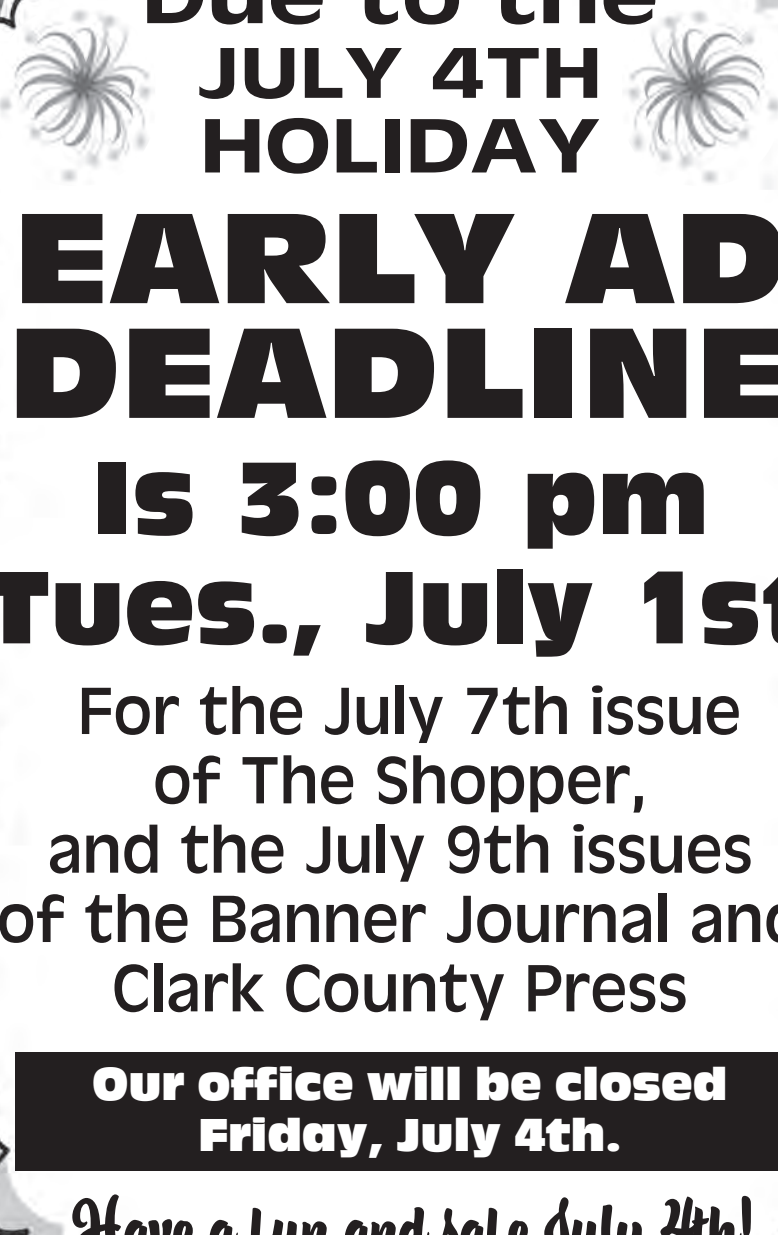
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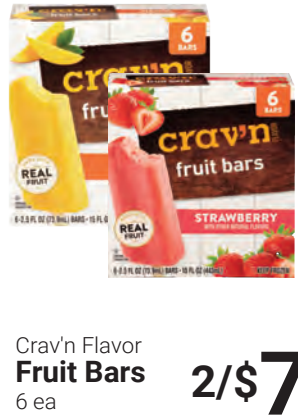
