**AND GOD SAYS . . .**  
**The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. Psalm 19:1**

Recently astronomers have been able to see more of the glories of the heavens since the building of the James Webb Space Telescope (JWST) launched into space on Dec. 25, 2021. Here's how NASA describes its expectations (science.nasa.gov>mission>webb):

Webb studies every phase in the history of our Universe, ranging from the first luminous glows after the Big Bang, to the formation of solar systems capable of supporting life on planets like Earth, to the evolution of our own Solar System.
